## ARCHITECTURAL / PROPERTY DESCRIPTION

### ARCHITECTURAL DESCRIPTION

"The Manse" is a one-and-one-half-story Craftsman Bungalow style residence built for the ministers of the Orengo Presbyterian Church. The plan is rectangular, supported by a concrete foundation with a basement. It is clad with clapboard siding, cornerboards and plain fascia. The roof is a medium-pitch gable covered with composition shingles and features two shed dormers on the north and south elevations. The south dormer has four original nine-over-one double-hung sash windows. Projecting eaves are supported by exposed rafters, with purlins and kneebraces at the gable ends. The brick chimney, located on the east elevation, has two twelve-paned sidelights. The main access is on the south elevation. The porch is sheltered by a bell-cast shed roof supported by two boxed posts resting upon a clapboard-filled railing. A handicap access ramp has been added to the entry steps. Fenestration includes a five-over-one sash with two six-over-one sidelights, and six-over-one and twelve-over-one double-hung sash windows. The interior is more formal than many Orengo residences, with a formal entry hall and stairs.

### CONTEXTUAL DESCRIPTION

The Manse is located east of the church and north of Birch Street. The original townsite of Orengo extends to the west with medium-density housing. Woods and a park extend to the east and south, respectively.

## HISTORY

### HISTORICAL SIGNIFICANCE

The church congregation constructed The Manse for \$3500 cash and a \$1500 loan in 1914. A garage was constructed in 1923. This residence is significant due to its connection with the Orengo Presbyterian Church and as a representation of the Craftsman Bungalow style in Orengo.
